EMBRACING AND EDUCATING SOCIETY'S NEGLECTED KIDS



We are coming to the end of the school year, and what a year it's been! We had three times the amount of students, a waiting list that continues to grow, and in May we will have the largest graduating class in the history of McAdams Academy! I want to take this opportunity to thank each and every one of you who have made this possible by financial contribution and selfless hours of

We are the **only program of our kind** in the city, but conversations I've had over the past ten years have brought up misconceptions about expelled students and their education. Let me expel some of those myths (instead of students!)

MYTH: CHILDREN NEED HARSHER DISCIPLINE TO KEEP THEM IN LINE

Every day, children in our community are abused and neglected by those who should be protecting them. These Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) harm a child's physical, emotional, and social well-being. The most noticeable impact of this trauma is often anti-social behavior, which accounts for 95% of school expulsions nationwide. Punishment cannot heal the emotional pain of an abused child. Children need a loving adult to walk beside them as they learn to correct their negative behavior.

FACT: WE ARE **HELPING KIDS** HEAL FROM TRAUMA

For the past decade, McAdams has provided a solution to families of expelled students in Sedgwick County. We continue their education while working on behavioral issues that keep them impoverished financially, relationally, educationally, and emotionally. We also provide counseling and guidance to parents struggling with their child's behavior.

MYTH: EVERY CHILD IN KANSAS CAN ATTEND SCHOOL

In Kansas, expelled students may be barred from attending school for an entire school year (186 days). During that year, they cannot go to schools in their district or neighboring districts; they have nowhere to attend school. Without someone teaching the expelled child how to make behavioral changes, half are expelled multiple times and eventually drop out of school. And the cycle continues; hurting children continue to be neglected.

FACT: MCADAMS RECEIVES NO FUNDING FROM LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS

For those children who rely on school lunches, we ensure that they receive two meals a day and provide them with personal hygiene items. Unlike public schools, the state does not reimburse McAdams for these meals. Our expenses continue through the summer as we have summer school. We also help these children work on the root causes underlying their behavior problems while earning high school credits.
